Irish: If you are unsure of level (Higher or Ordinary), books may be purchased at school in September. Pupils who are exempt from Irish on grounds of a diagnosed learning difficulty will normally study remedial English and Maths. Pupils whose education up to 12 years of age (or up to and including the final year of their primary education) was received outside the State and where they did not have opportunity to engage in the study of Irish will also be exempt from Irish. Those pupils who have not received their Primary Education in Ireland, will study Business Studies instead of Irish.
